



FRENCH EDUCATIONNAL SYSTEM

I. Children less than 9 years old

For children who are less than 9 years old, the enrolment is done directly at the school of your choice.

II. Children more than 9 years old

To enrol children in a catholic/private secondary school, you have to contact the school directly. The "Direction Diocésaine de l'Enseignement Catholique" does not centralise information concerning bilingual lessons. However, the secondary school « Blanche de Castille » offers European courses in English:

To enrol children in a state secondary school, you have to contact CASNAV 44. Children who are more than 9 years old have to pass a knowledge mother tongue test. CASNAV 44 helps families recently arrived in Nantes for the enrolment in primary and secondary schools.
